



# REGULATION CALL FOR PAPERS

## **1. Introduction**

The IHSHG will hold our first Call for Papers dedicated to the discussion and reflection of historical investigations produced by young researchers. In this first edition, the selected candidates will be invited to participate in one of our "Confabulating" interviews, to be held in the months of June/July.

In the absence of a main subject, all investigations, concluded or in progress and in any chronology, geographical or historiographic area will be valid and accepted. The most innovative contributions and those that apply interdisciplinary methodologies will be privileged when considering selection.

Note that this call for papers is not limited to works in the specific area of History, but also covers other areas of Social Sciences (such as Archaeology, Anthropology, Heritage, etc.)

## **2. Participation**

The Call for Papers is open to all young researchers of any nationality; we will accept submissions from students, graduates, masters, doctoral students and doctors alike, linked to studies in the fields of History and other related Social Sciences.

## **3. Dates and Phases of Call For Papers**

- 1 March- 15th April: **Applications**
- 15th April- 15th May: **Selection Phase**
- 16th May: **Disclosure of the three selected papers**
- Dates to be decided in June/July (three Wednesdays) for public presentation and dissemination of the selected research works (certificate to be awarded)

## 4. Presentation of the application

All proposals must be submitted in English, using the following registration form:

All registrations must include:

- Name; Group / University / Individual  
Address/email/telephone number
- If a group, please give the names of all contributing members
- Title
- Submit an abstract (maximum 500 words), which should include:
  - Framework
  - Description
  - Objectives
  - Methodology
  - Main Conclusions / Results
- As an option, a video or a document can be submitted in addition, to better illustrate the paper presented.

After the correct receiving of submitted files, a confirmation message will be sent. ## **5. Text Formatting:**

- Font – Times New Romam
- Line Spacing – 1.5
- Abstract – 500 words (max.)
- Keywords – 4 (max.)

## **6. Selection and Jury**

Of all applications submitted, the three best papers will be selected.

## **7. Selection criteria**

The Jury will take the following criteria into account:

- Use of interdisciplinary approach(es)
- Level of innovation and differentiation of the paper
- Degree of creativity
- Correction of Written Language

## **8. Winners**

The three winners and their respective papers will be announced on 16th May. First through direct contact with the winners, then via IHSYG social networks.

## **9. Responsibility**

The IHSYG cannot be held responsible for cancelling, postponing, or changing to the call for papers due to unforeseen circumstances.

## **10. Acceptance of regulation**

Participation in the Call for Papers implies full acceptance of the rules of this regulation. The Jury's decision is final and there will be no appeal.

## **11. Additional Notes**

The responsibility for deliberation on omission cases to which the regulation does not respond shall fall upon the IHSYG Board of Directors.

The detection of any form of plagiarism implies the immediate annulment of the application.
